GARDENS AND LAWN CARE

- DON'T use excess pesticides, weed killers or fertilizers
- DO use environmentally safe products whenever you can.
- DON'T dump garden or grass clippings in the street.
- DO dispose of excess pesticides, weed killers or fertilizers at a recycling location.

AUTO CARE

- DON'T wash or degrease your car on the driveway or in the street.
- DO use a commercial car wash (where they treat the waste water).
- DO wash your car on your yard using biodegradable soap so the water infiltrates into the ground.
- DO repair leaks and dispose of auto fluids or batteries at designated recycling locations.
- DON'T hose spills or leaks into the street.
- DO cover spills and leaks with kitty litter, then sweep them up, and dispose of them in the garbage.



PETS

- DO be sure to pick up the waste when walking your pet.
- DO dispose of pet waste by putting it in the garbage.

Here are some things you can do:



HOUSE CLEANING AND PAINTING

- DO use environmentally-friendly cleaning products whenever possible.
- DO use all cleaning products sparingly.
- DO dispose of all excess cleaning agents, solvents, paints, or varnish at a recycling location.
- DON'T dump cleaning agents, solvents, paints, or varnish on the ground or in the street.
